

Conference Venue & Parking

Sheffield Hallam University's City Campus is conveniently located directly opposite the railway station in the city centre. The University post code is S1 1WB, as there is limited on street parking available on Arundel Street please see <https://www.sheffield.gov.uk/roads/travel/driving/parking/city-centre.html> for details of all car parks.

*****Please note that you can park at [NCP Arundel Gate](#) for a reduced rate of £5 per 10 hour day. To get this reduced rate you need to collect the yellow chip on entry to the car park and take this chip to the university reception to get it scanned. When you return to the carpark you then need to put the chip in their machine where you will be charged £5*****

Travel to Sheffield

Sheffield is well served by rail and road. The city is easily reached by rail from Newcastle (2 hours), Manchester (1½ hours) and Birmingham (1½ hours) and the principal services on the north-east/south-west rail route pass through Sheffield. The M1 motorway (junction 33) gives direct access to the city from north and south. Access from the west is via the A57 and from the east via the M18/M1. The nearest international airports are Manchester, East Midlands and Robin Hood Doncaster-Sheffield - the websites for these airports will have all of the information you need to hire a car if you need to.
